

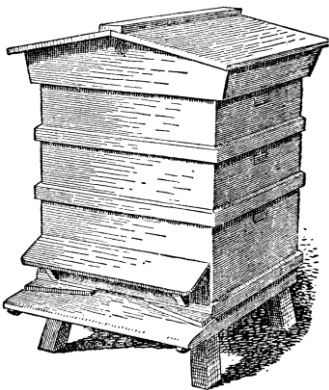
# Beekeeping Taster Sessions 2020
